





1. Remove product from box and identify all parts as shown in FIGURE 1.



 $\textbf{2.} \ \text{Inserst } \textbf{C} \ \text{into } \textbf{E} \ \ \text{with the } \textbf{THREADS} \ \text{oriented towards the ceiling as shown in } \textit{FIGURE 2}.$



3. Determine height between the floor and ceiling and use the chart in *FIGURE 3* to determine the appropriate hole in **B** and continue to **Step 4**.



4. Insert **B** into **E** and align the appropriate hole in **B** with the hole in **E** as shown in *FIGURE 4*. Secure by pressing **K** through both.



5. Place **D** on the floor at target location and insert **A** into **B** and **B** into **D** as shown in *FIGURE 5*.



6. Making sure the Product is level, tighten the nut on $\bf C$ using $\bf H$ as shown in *FIGURE 6*, until the product is secured between the floor and ceiling with ABSOLUTELY NO sliding. Tighten set screw on $\bf C$ with $\bf J$ and cover area with $\bf F$.





7. Unscrew BOLTS in G with J and position to desired location on E. Retighten BOLTS as shown in FIGURE 7.



8. This step is only **required** for ceilings taller than 10' or if angled. If your ceiling is angled, go to **Step 9** first. Secure with screws (**L**) as shown in *FIGURE 8*, making sure that **L** goes through the **CEILING JOISTS**. If the **Floor** is ceramic or concrete, drill holes first.



9. IMPORTANT: For angled ceilings remove **PIVOT ISOLATOR** and reassemble as shown in *FIGURE* 9. Go to **Step 8** to finish assembly. (Tools not provided)
